In January of 2002, President Bush signed the **No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act** into law. One of the requirements of this law is that all school districts issue School Report Cards to give parents information about their child's school in terms of academic achievement and the professional qualifications of its teachers. By making this information available each year, parents will learn how the school is doing, what our goals are, and what they can do to work more effectively with us.

No Child Left Behind established a goal that all teachers will be licensed and highly qualified. As you can see on the first page of the Report Card under Educator Data (2008-2009), 98.8% of Nauset High School's current teachers are licensed and 98.2% of the staff members are identified as highly qualified in that they have subject certification for the area that they teach. Another goal set by **No Child Left Behind** is that all students will be Proficient in English Language Arts and Mathematics by 2014. We have actually met this goal as indicated by the section entitled Adequate Yearly Progress Data, which follows the 2007 Massachusetts NAEP Results. Our performance rating in both English Language Arts and Mathematics is very high. The final pages of the Report Card provide you with information on the most current performance ratings in English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science and Technology/Engineering for tenth graders by subjects and subgroups.
