I am writing to provide you with some important information about bus transportation for the 2020-2021 school year. The Parent Transportation Commitment Survey was instrumental in placing students who need bus transportation on a bus. Students have been assigned a seat on both the morning and afternoon bus runs. At this time, we cannot accommodate exceptions or changes to these bus runs.

If circumstances change and a student needs bus transportation, it may take some time to get them a seat on a bus due to bus capacity restrictions. Every effort will be made to accomplish this as quickly as possible but parents are reminded that it will take additional time and will not happen overnight.

Bus routes are posted on the Nauset website at www.nausetschools.org. Routes **have changed**, so please take a moment to review the stops. Additionally, if anyone would like to volunteer as a bus monitor for the first three weeks of school, please contact Lori Newcomb in the Business Office.
