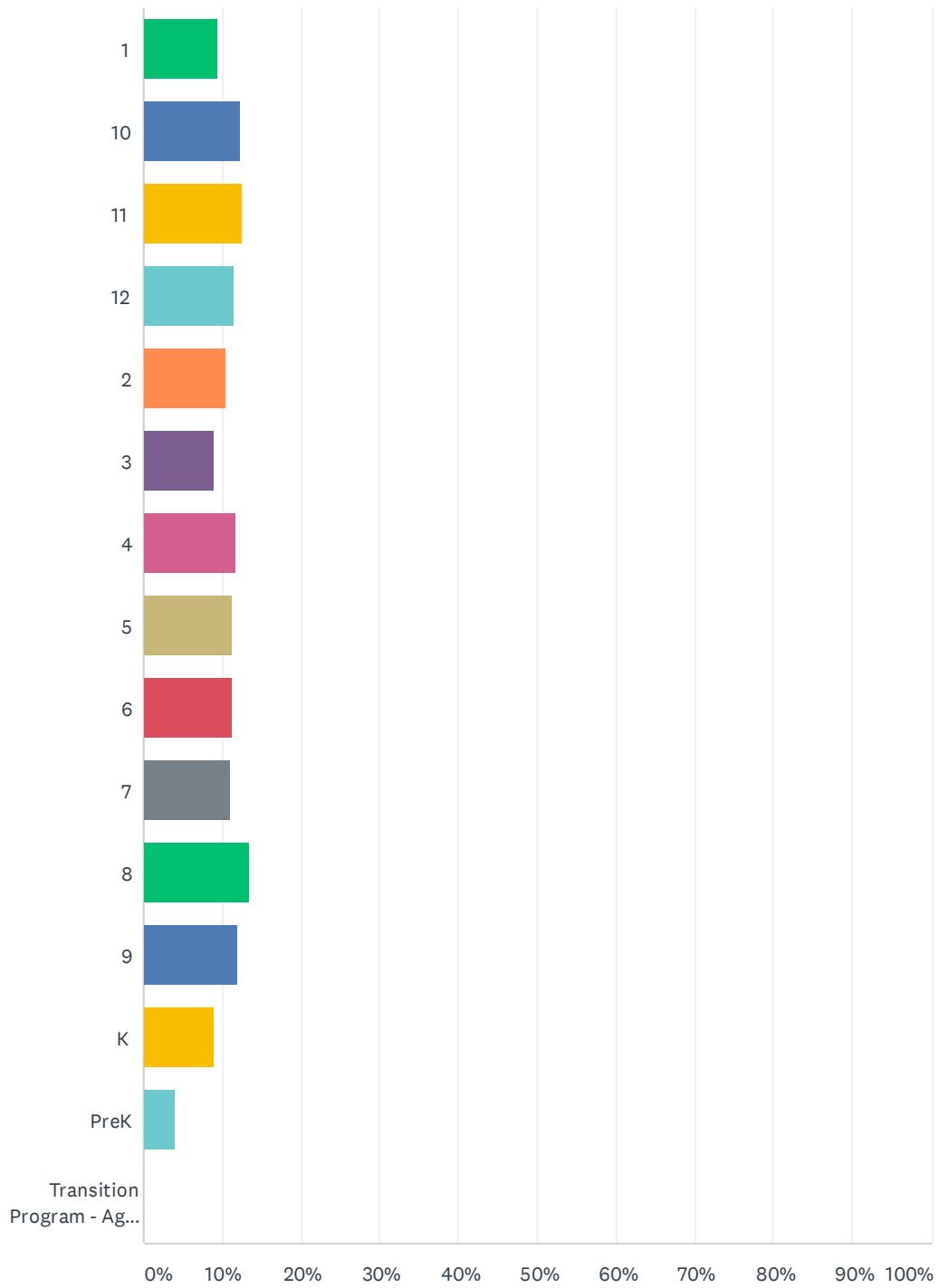


Q1 What grade(s) will your child(ren) attend next year? Check all that apply.

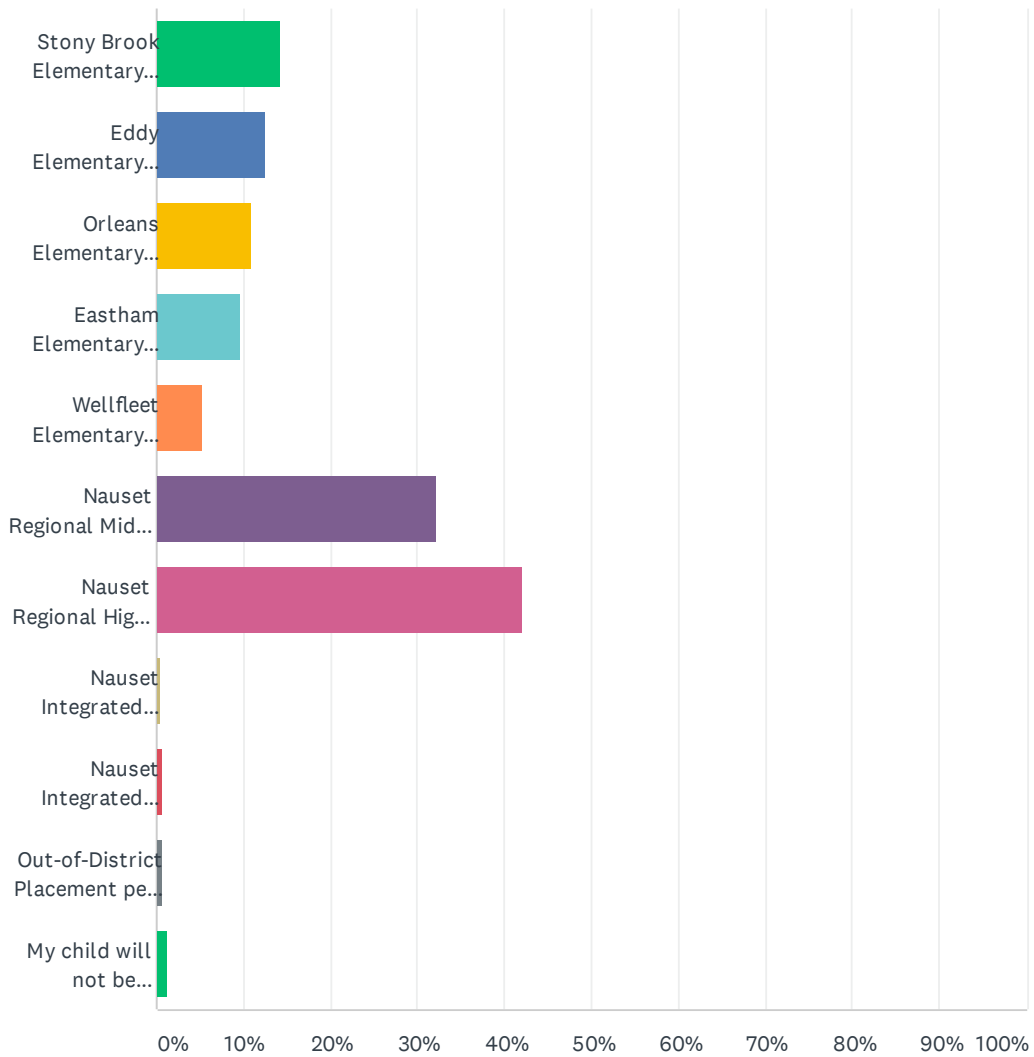

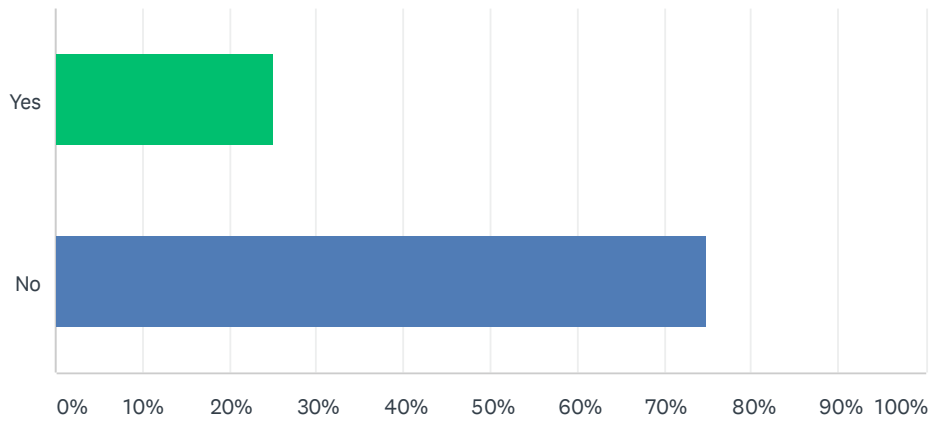

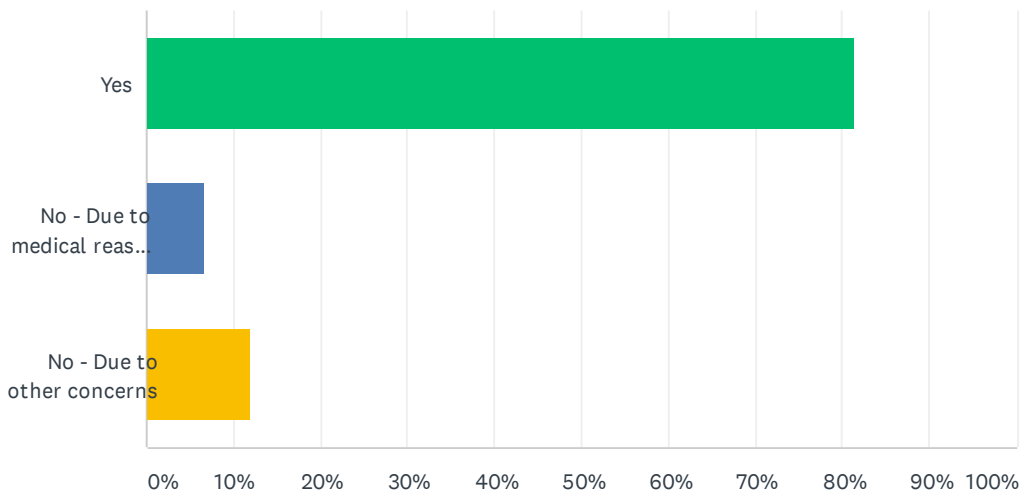

Q4 If all DESE physical distancing guidelines are met and safety precautions are satisfied, do you plan to send your child back to school for in-person learning?

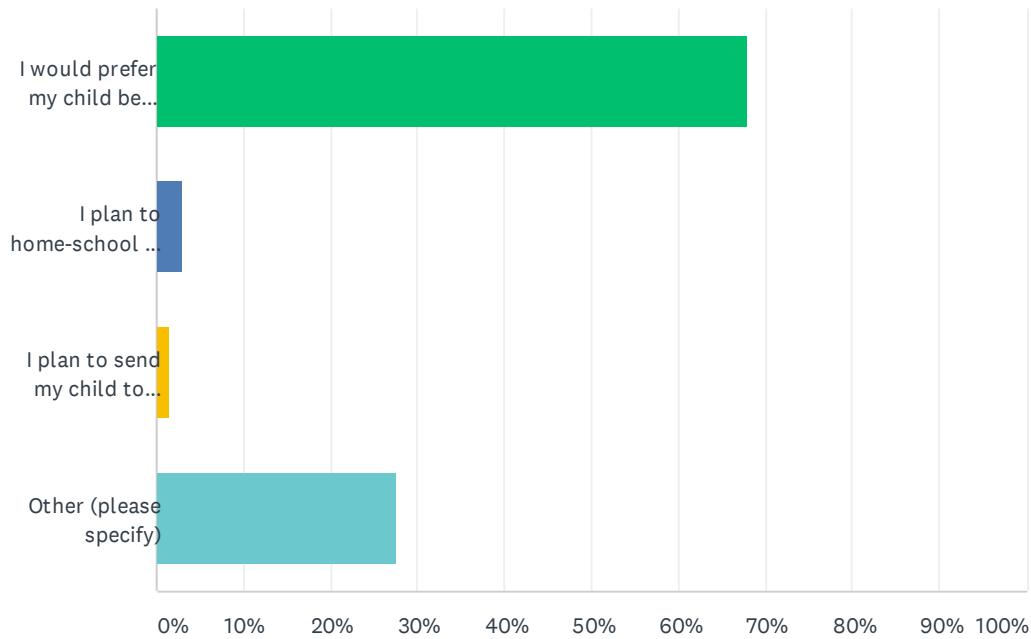

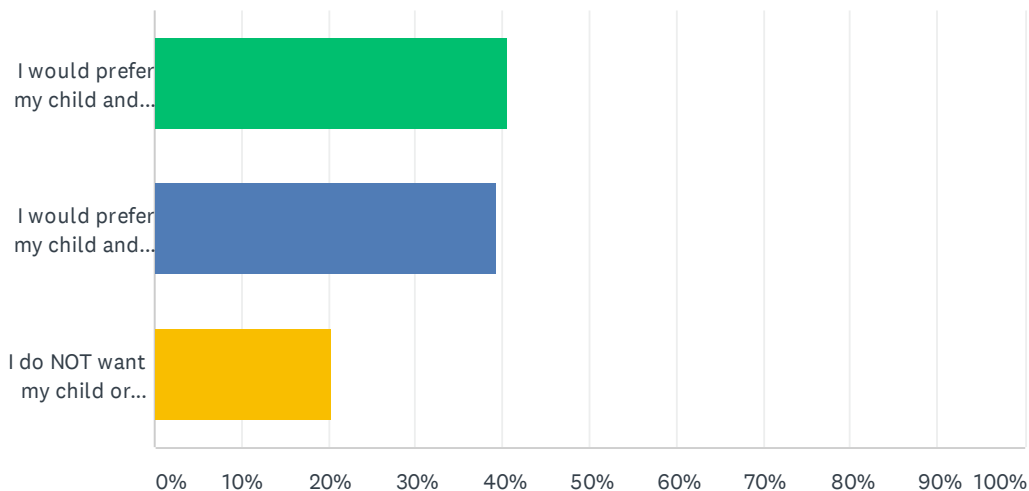

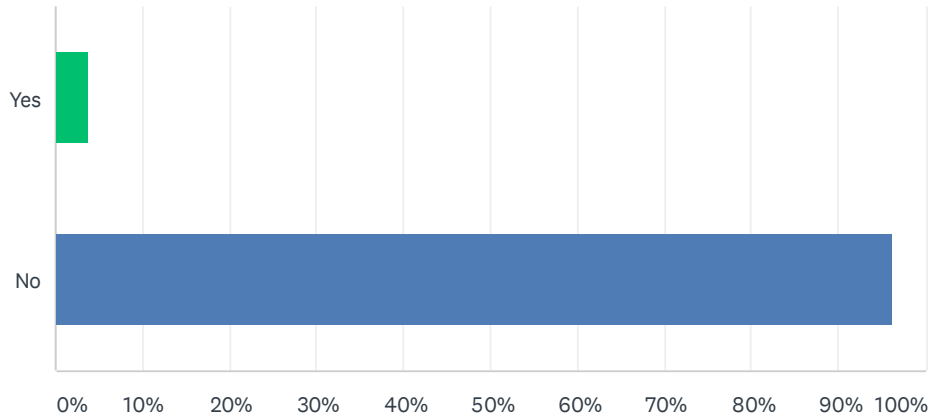

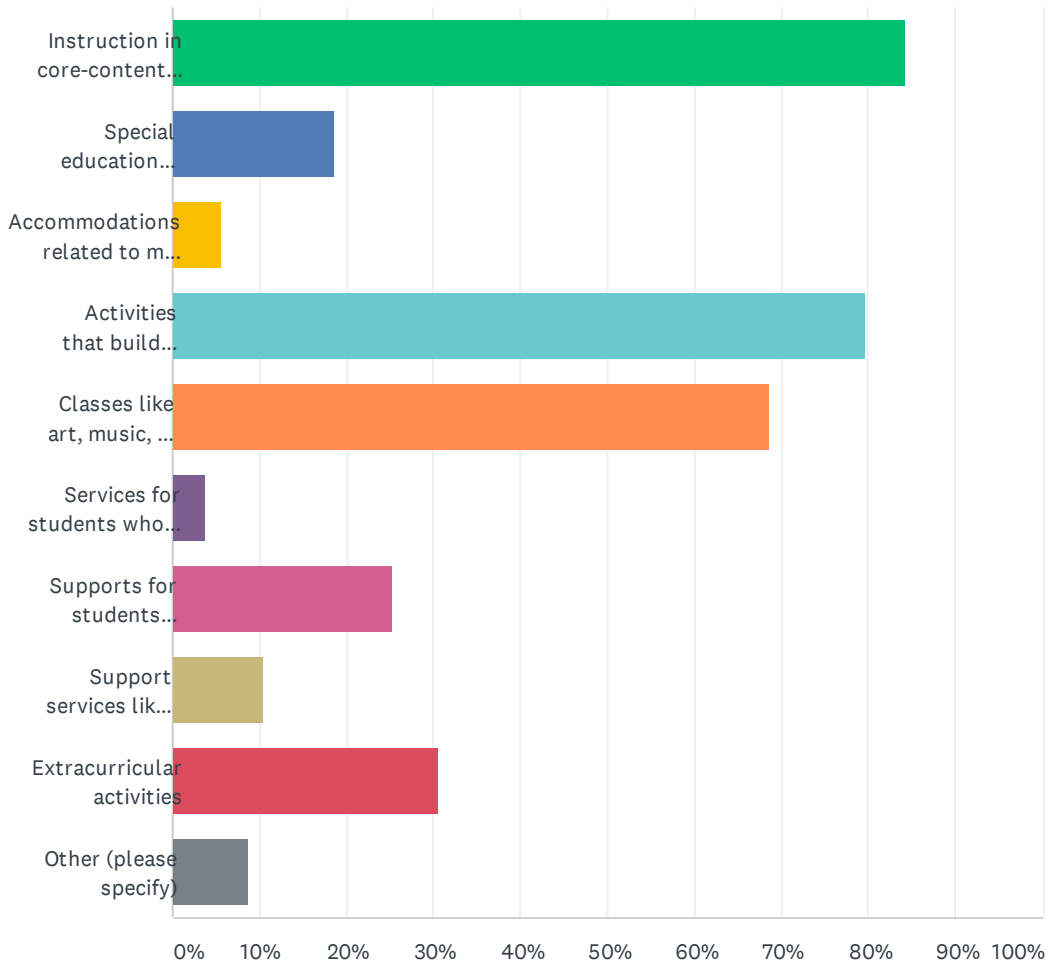

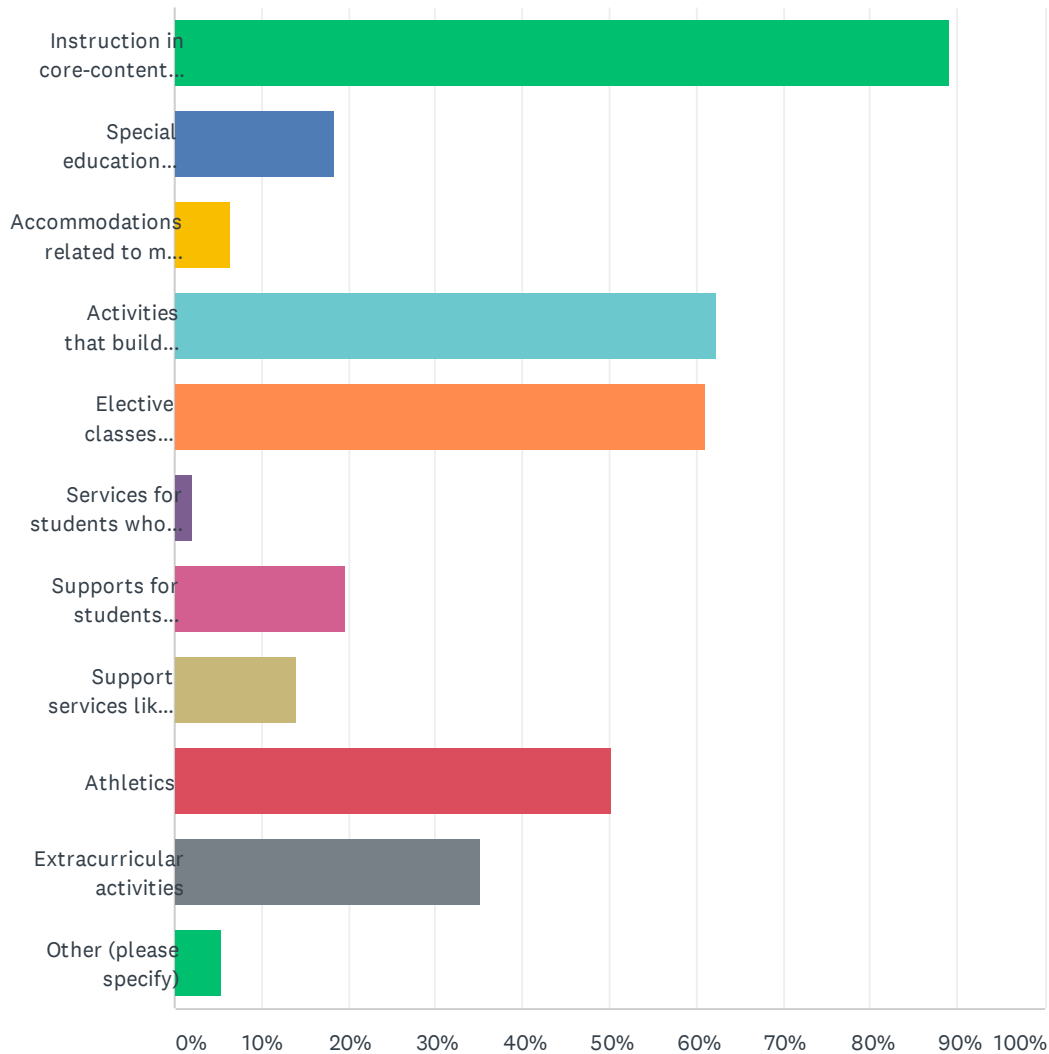

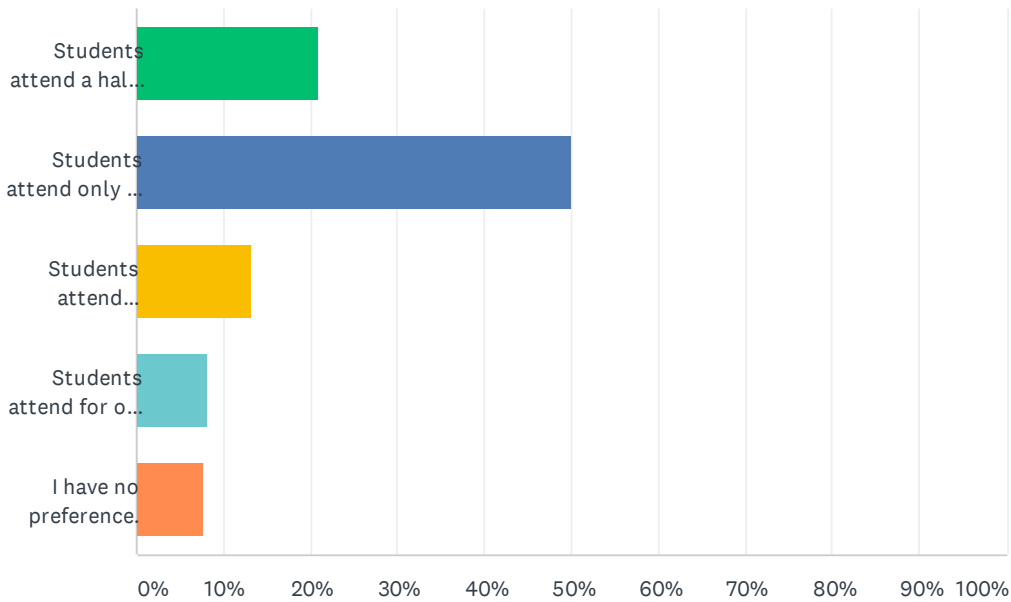

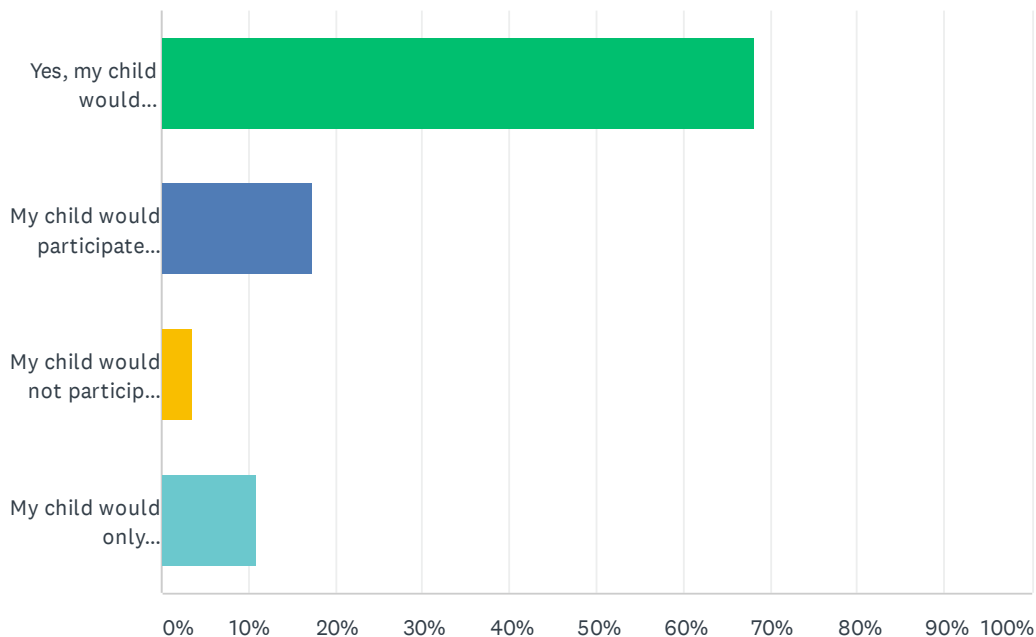

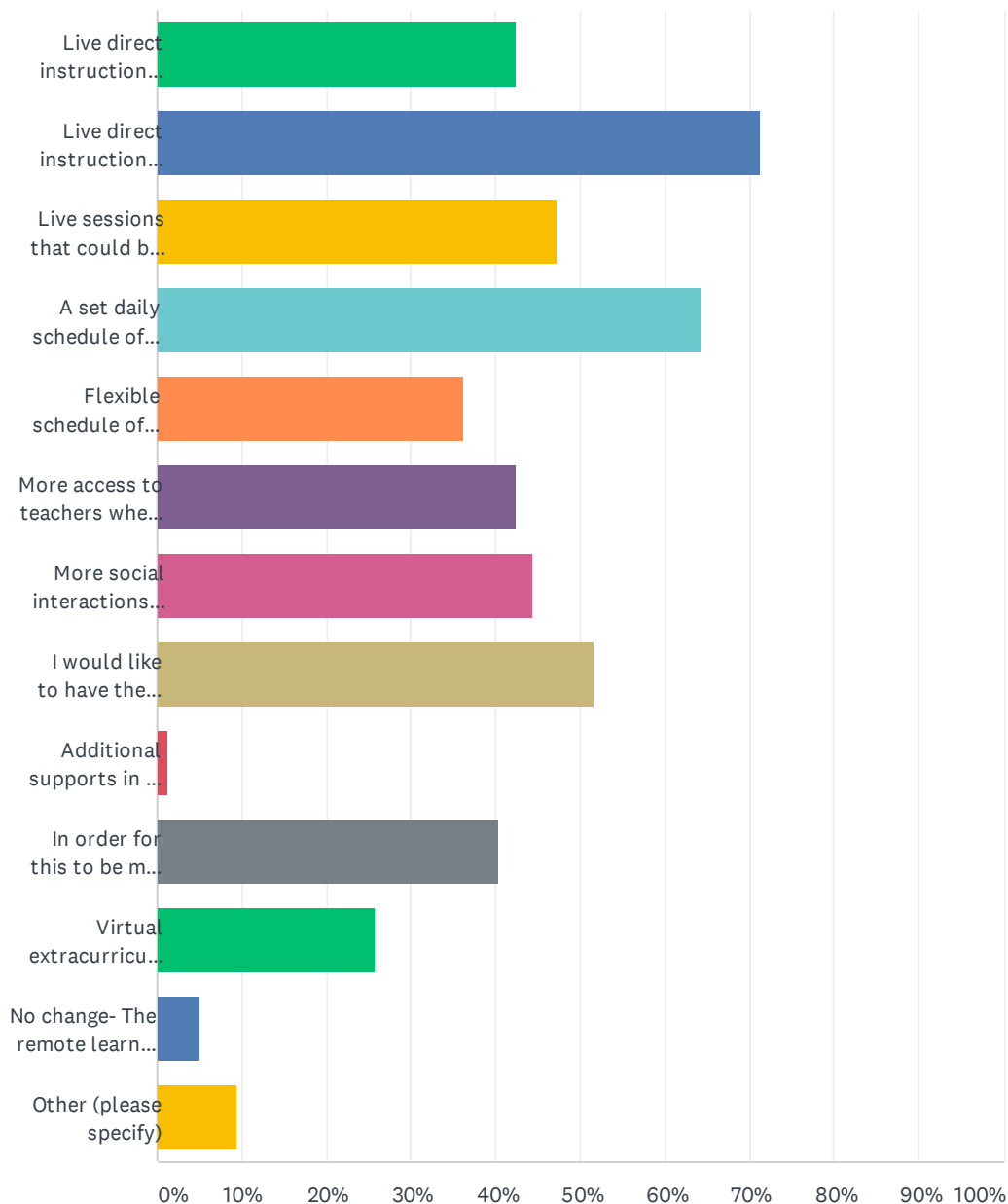

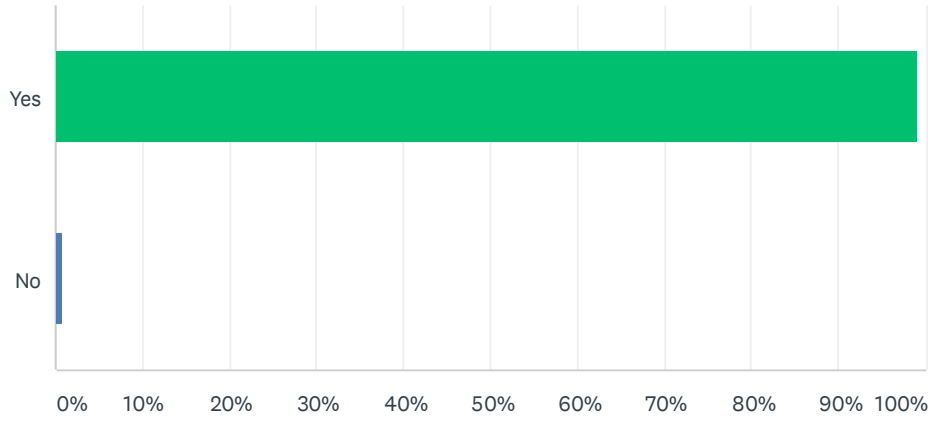

Q13 Do you have access to internet connectivity for student remote learning?

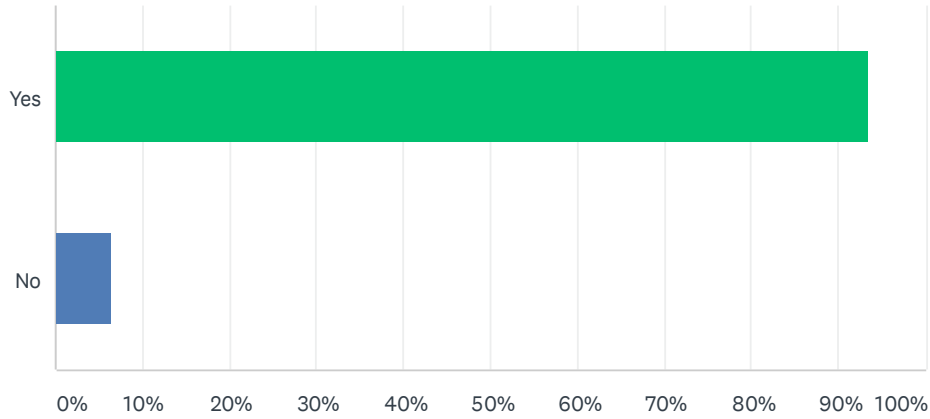

Q14 Do you have sufficient bandwidth (internet speed) to support the remote learning needs of all children and adults in your household?

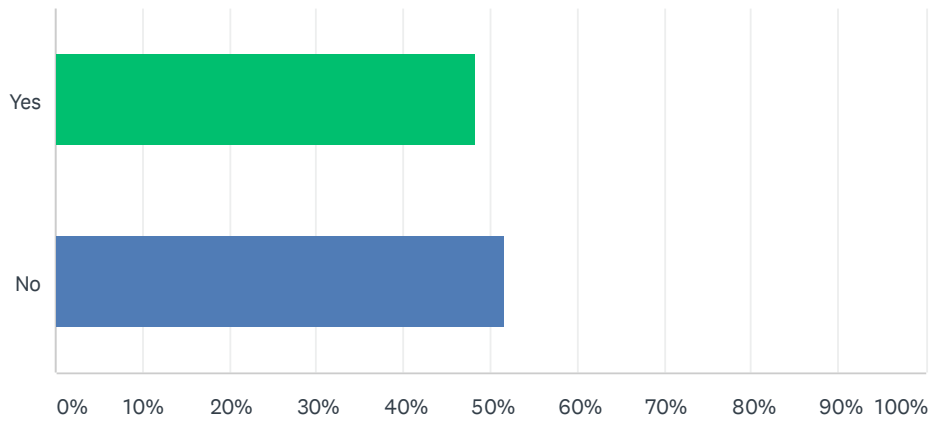

Q15 [Elementary only] Will your child need to borrow a school iPad in order to participate in hybrid or remote learning?

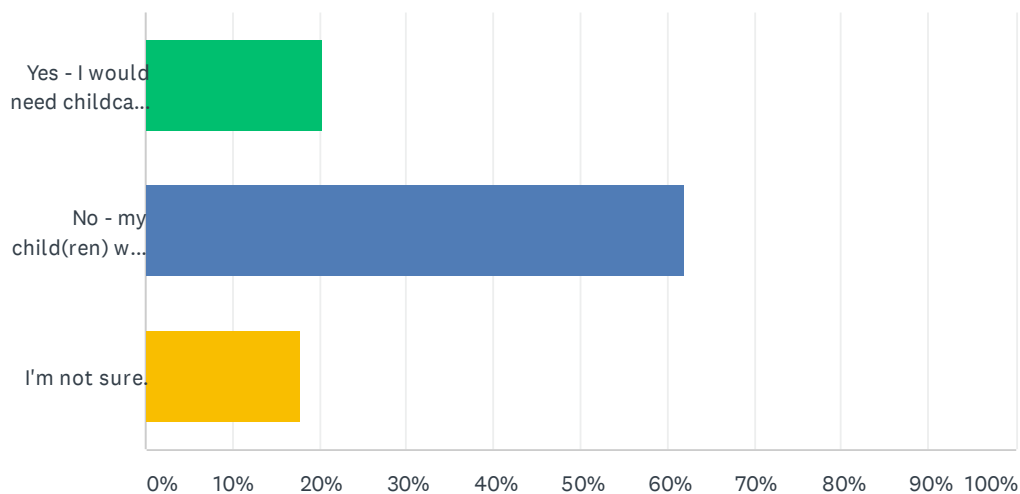

Q16 If the school district is required to conduct a hybrid or remote model for learning, would this present a childcare issue for you on the days or times when your child is not in school?

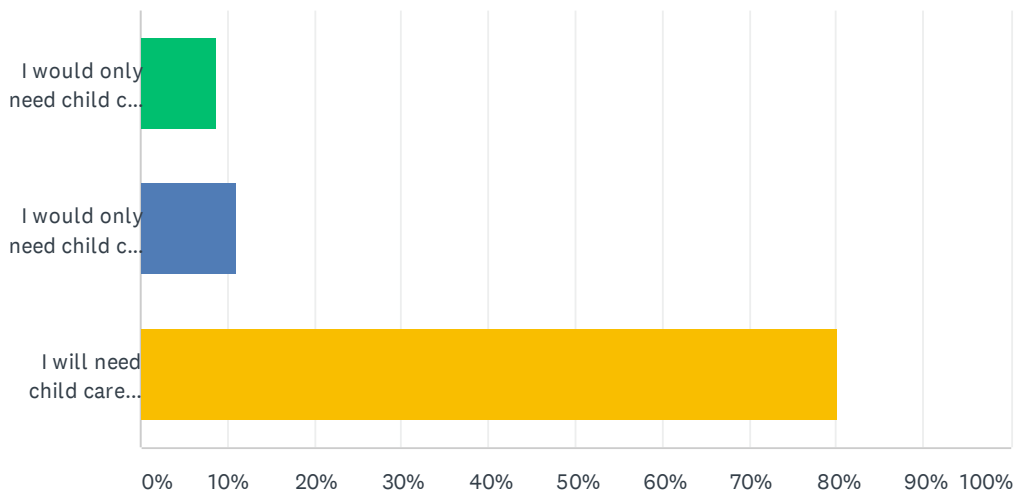

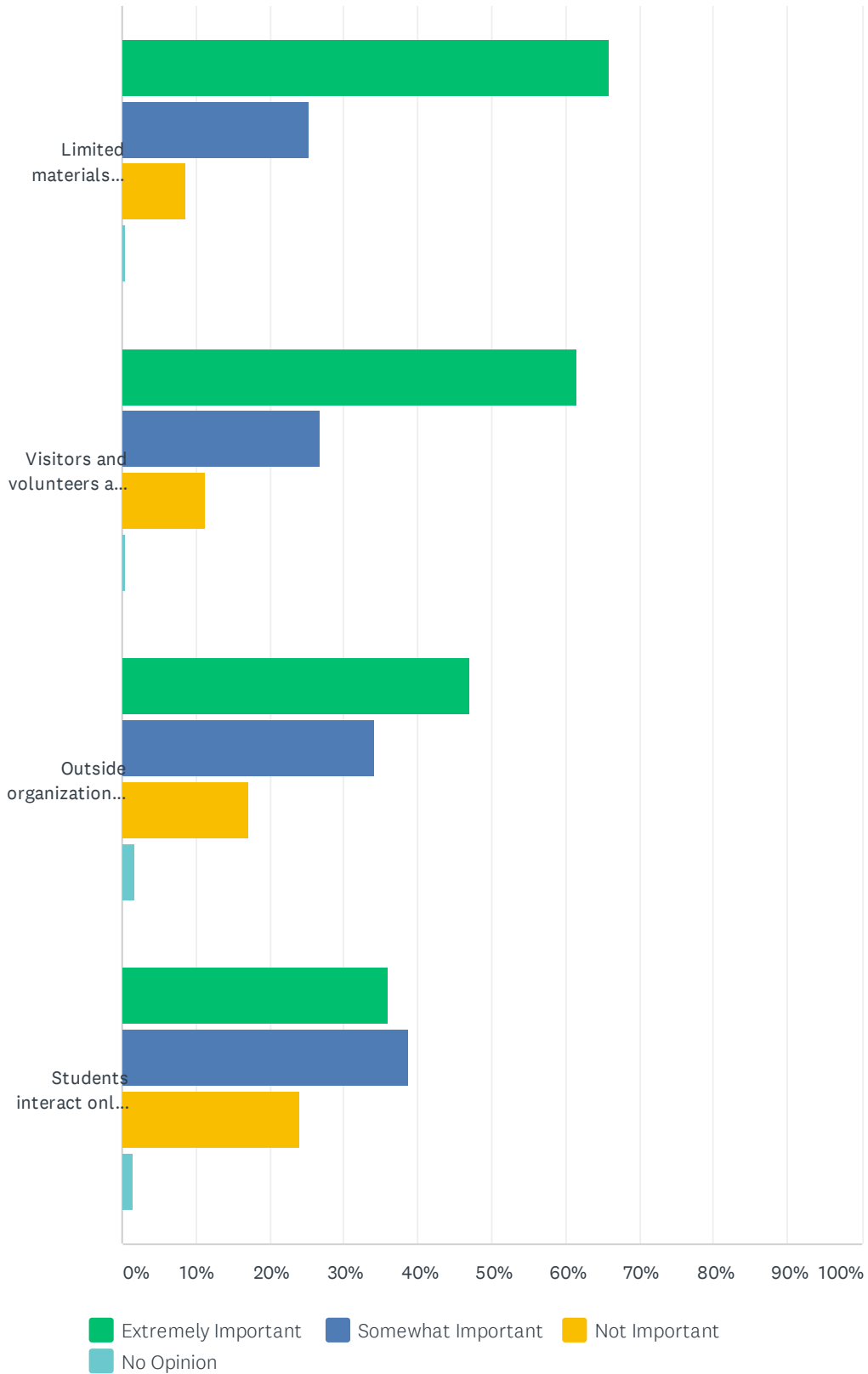

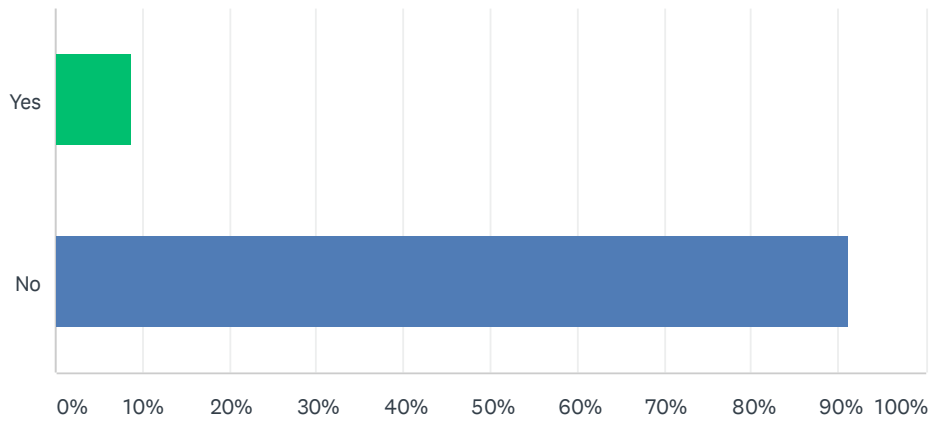

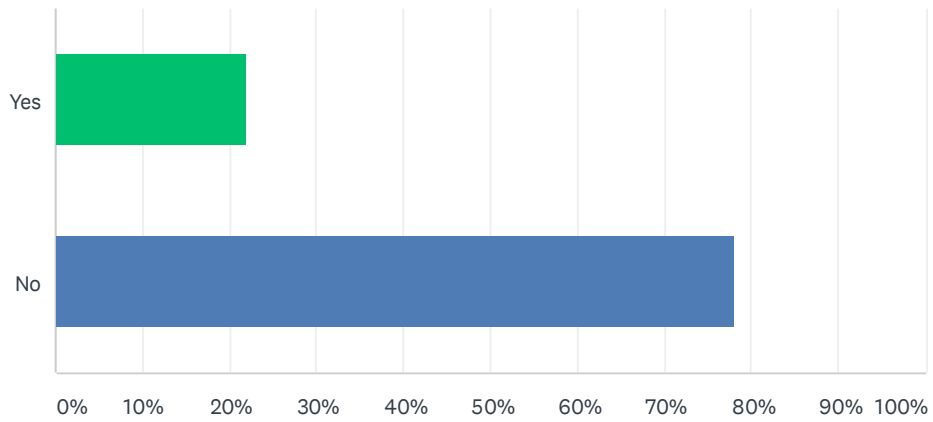

Q20 When school is open, would your child utilize the breakfast program if available in your child's school?

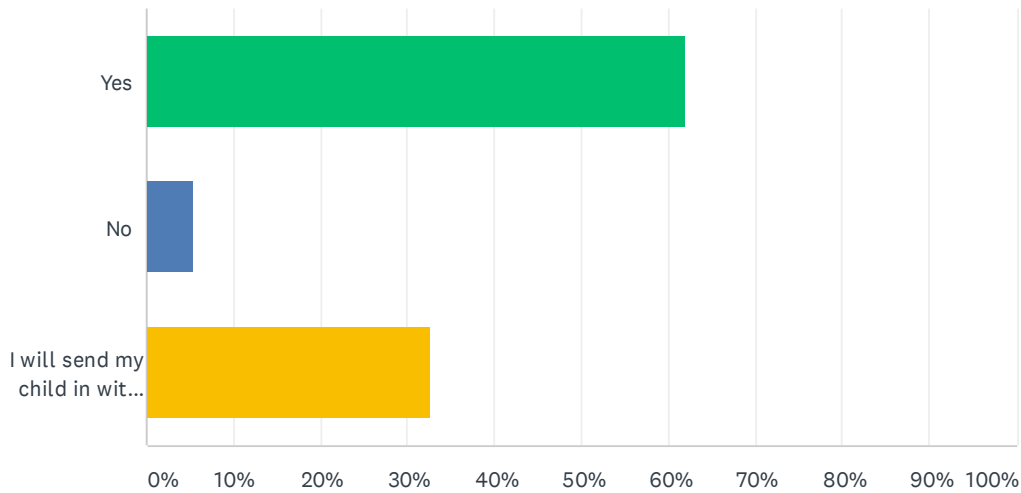

Q21 When school is open and hot lunch is offered through the cafeteria, would you have your child(ren) buy hot lunch (at least some of the time)?

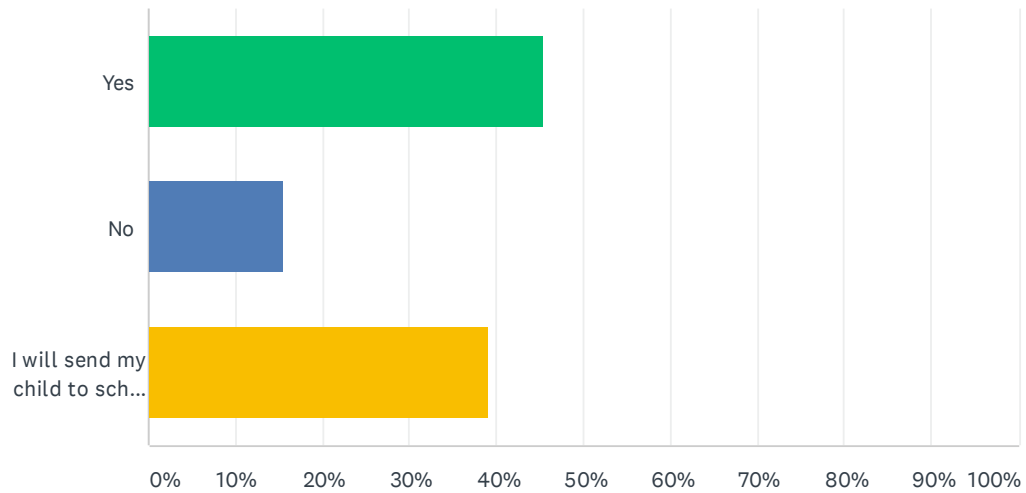
