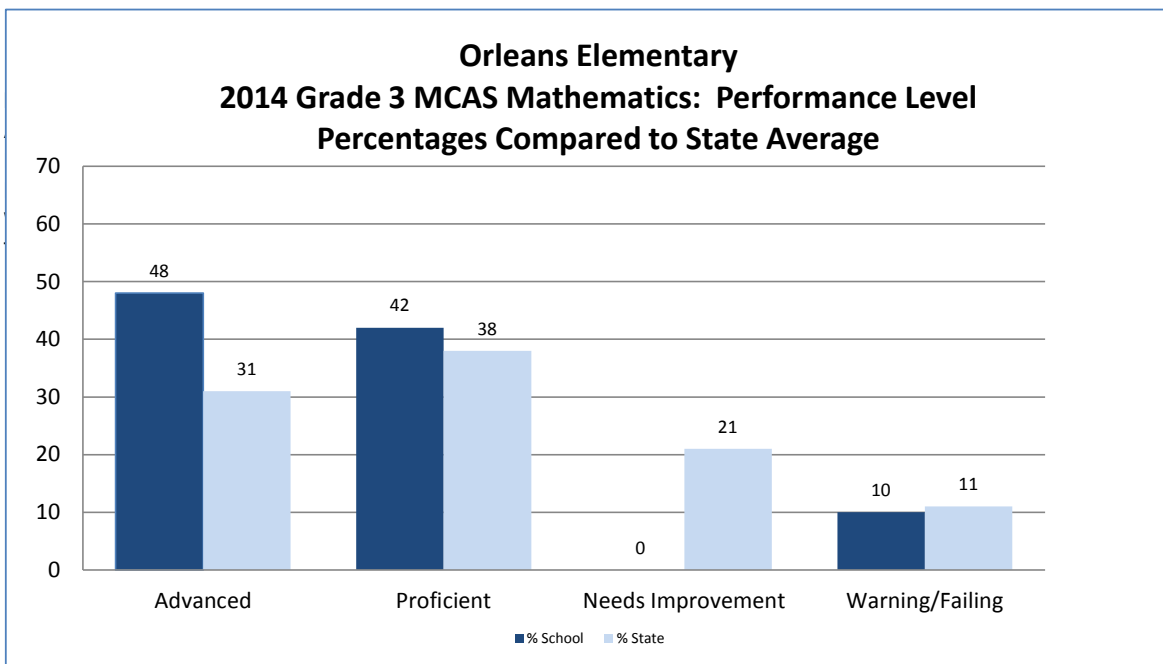
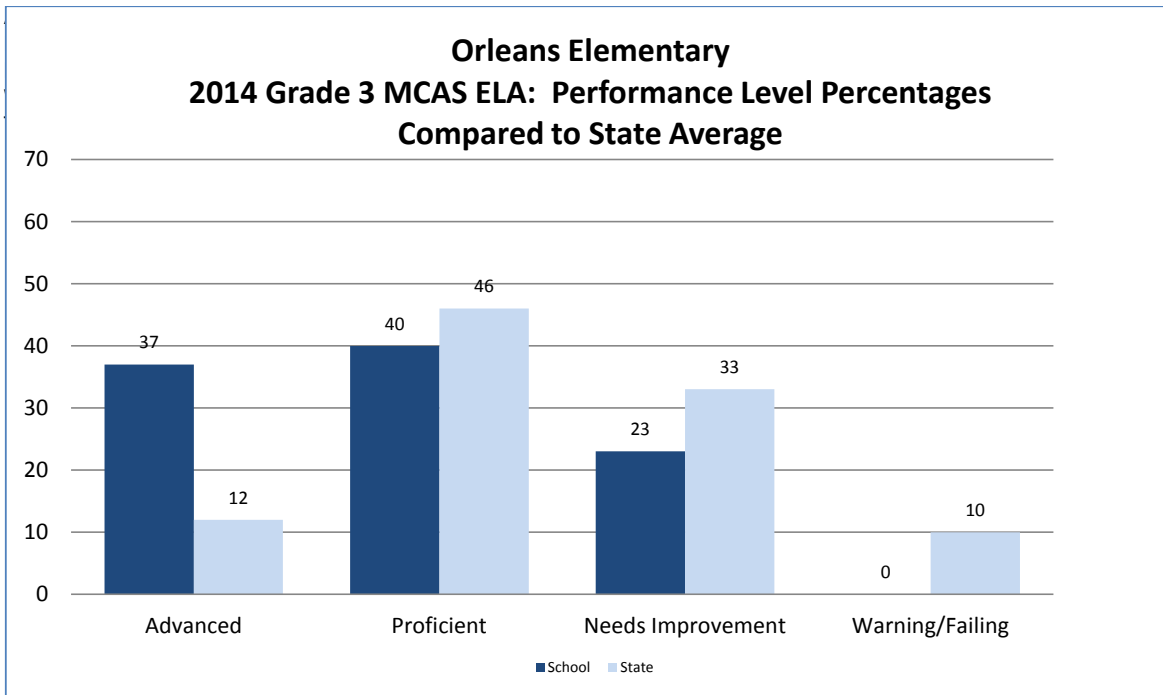
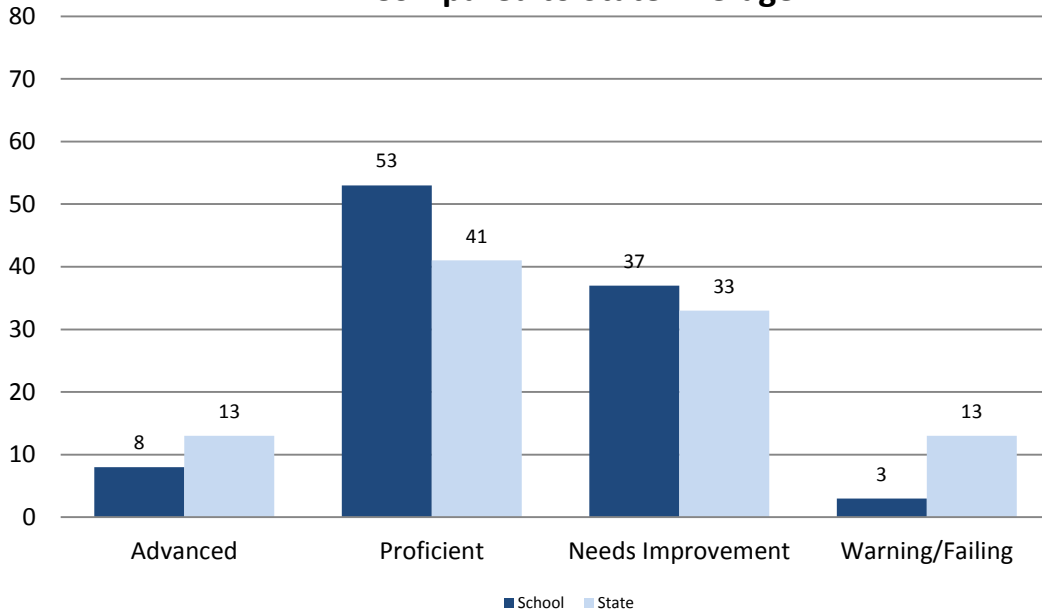


2014 MCAS Scores: Orleans Elementary Level of Performance

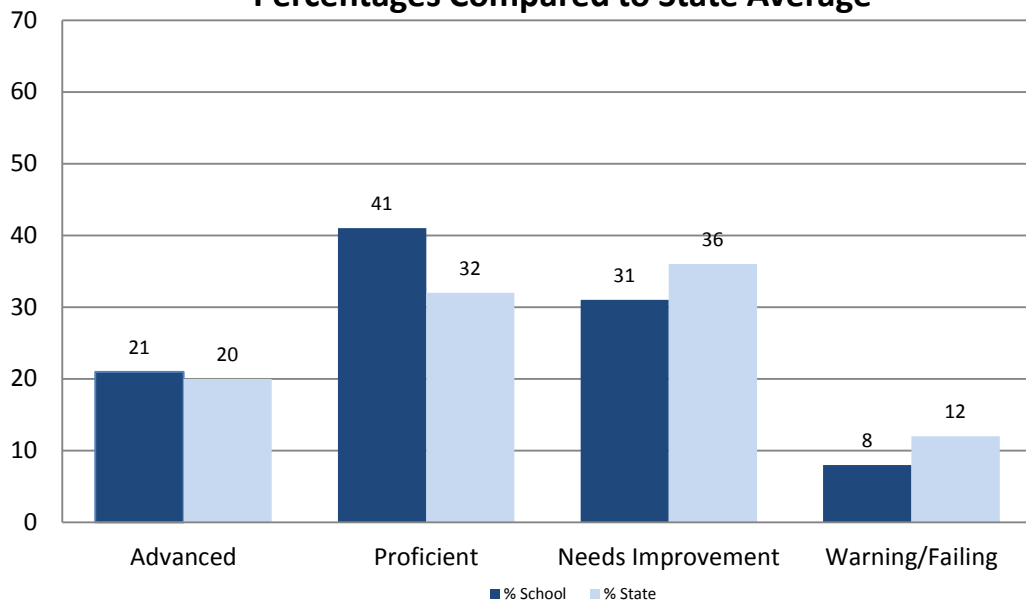
In 2014, Orleans Elementary School earned a Composite Performance Index (CPI) of 89.1 in ELA and 89.3 in mathematics for all students. Ninety percent of grade 3 students scored Advanced or Proficient in ELA. In grade 5, 85% of students scored Advanced or Proficient in math and 92% scored Advanced or Proficient in science and technology. These percentages are significantly above the State averages, particularly in the Advanced scoring category. In addition, Orleans Elementary School [OES] was on target for 'narrowing proficiency gaps' in mathematics and their median student growth percentile of 64 is considered 'Above Average' growth and is 13 points above the State target of 51. Orleans' commitment to education translates into many positives including a ranking at the 84th percentile when compared to similar schools across the State. OES will continue to engage in a cycle of inquiry which includes data analysis and dialogue to ensure we provide an exemplary learning environment for all students. This process requires us to continually reflect upon curriculum, instruction, and assessments in an effort to meet the needs of all students.



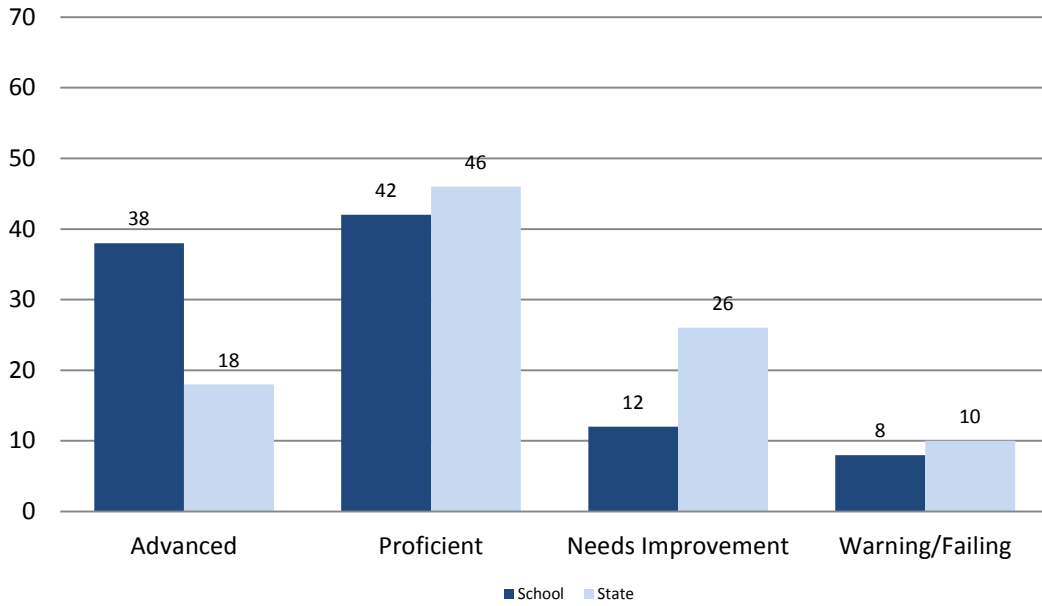

Compared to State Average



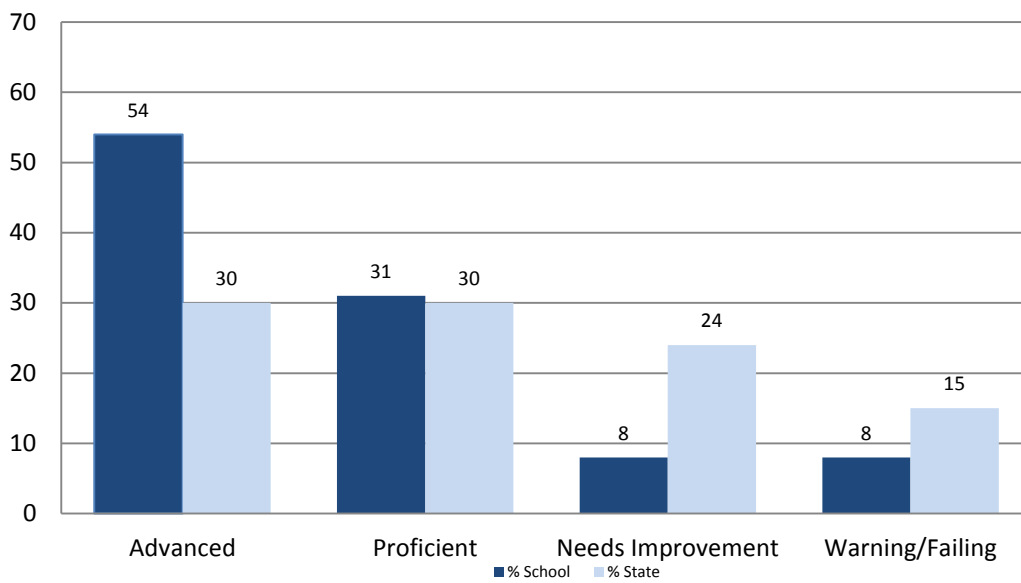
