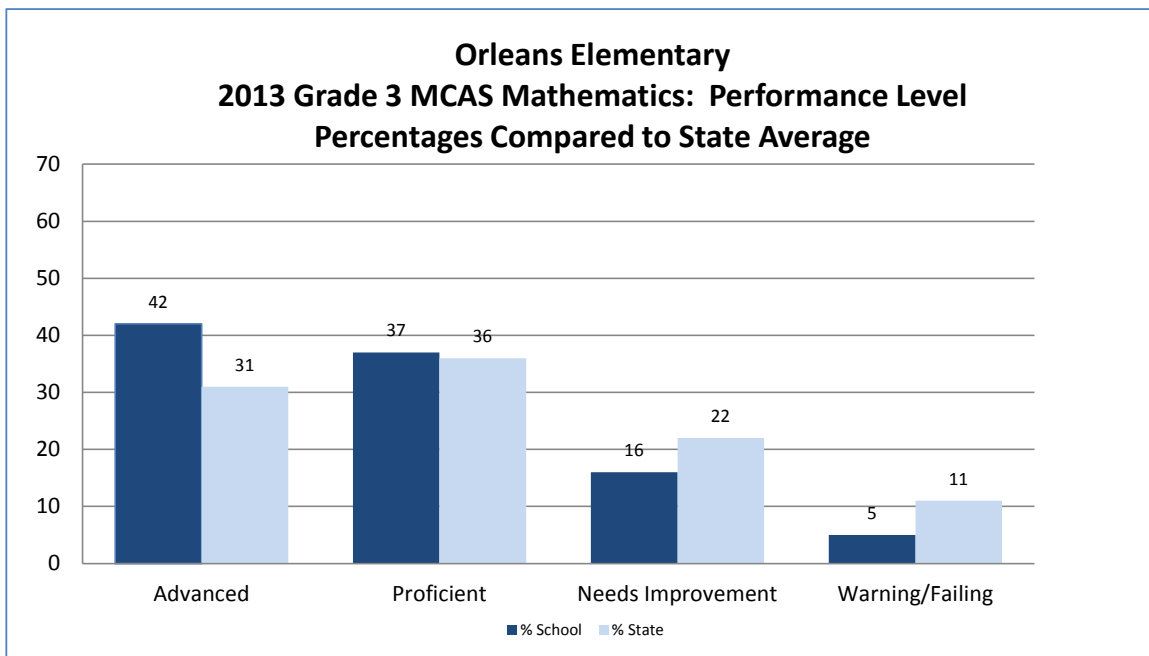
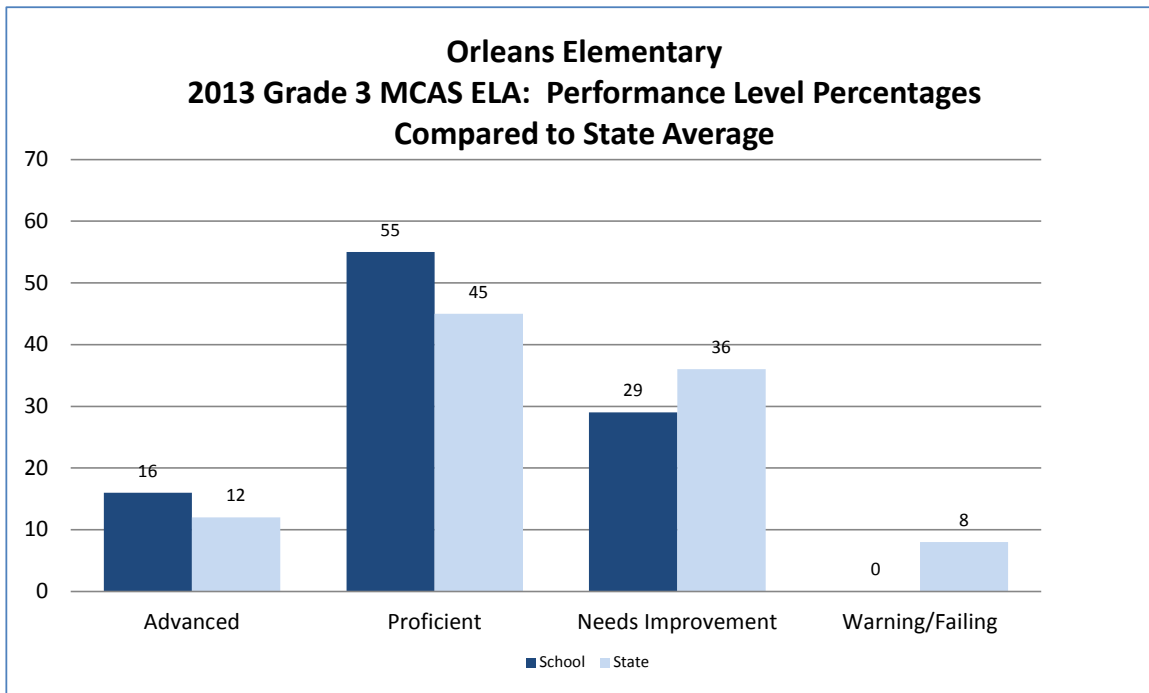
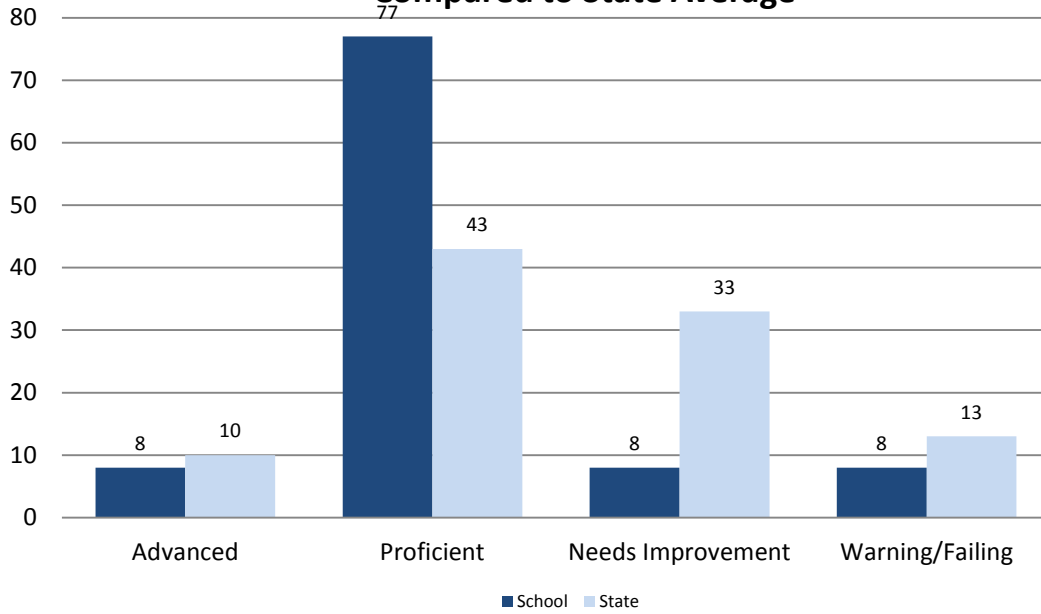


2013 MCAS Scores: Orleans Elementary Level of Performance

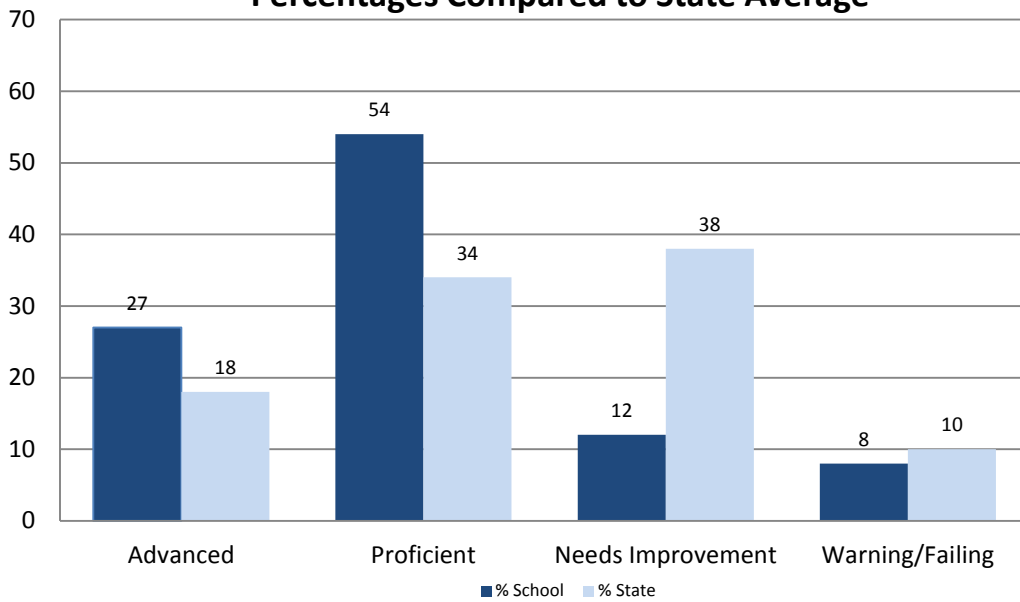
In 2013, Orleans Elementary School earned a Composite Performance Index (CPI) of 92 in ELA for all students. The CPI for all students rose by 2.5 percentage points to 92.9 in math and by 1.1 percentage points to 95.6 in science. Both of these scores result in an Above Target rating. Eighty-four percent of grade 5 students scored Advanced or Proficient in ELA, 91% in math, and 91% in science. Eighty-five percent of grade 4 students scored Advanced or Proficient in ELA, and 81% in math. In addition, OES received extra credit points in science and math for increasing the percentage of students scoring Advanced by 10% or more. Student Growth Percentages are "Above Target" in ELA and math. To maintain excellence, we engage in a cycle of inquiry which includes data analysis and dialogue to ensure we provide an exemplary learning environment for all students. This process requires us to continually reflect upon curriculum, instruction, and assessments in an effort to meet the needs of all students. Our commitment to education translates into many positives. For example, compared to 941 similar schools, Orleans Elementary School ranks 29th in grade 4 ELA and 53rd in grade 4 math. In addition, out of 879 similar schools, Orleans ranks 10th in the state for grade 5 science, and 24th in grade 5 math.



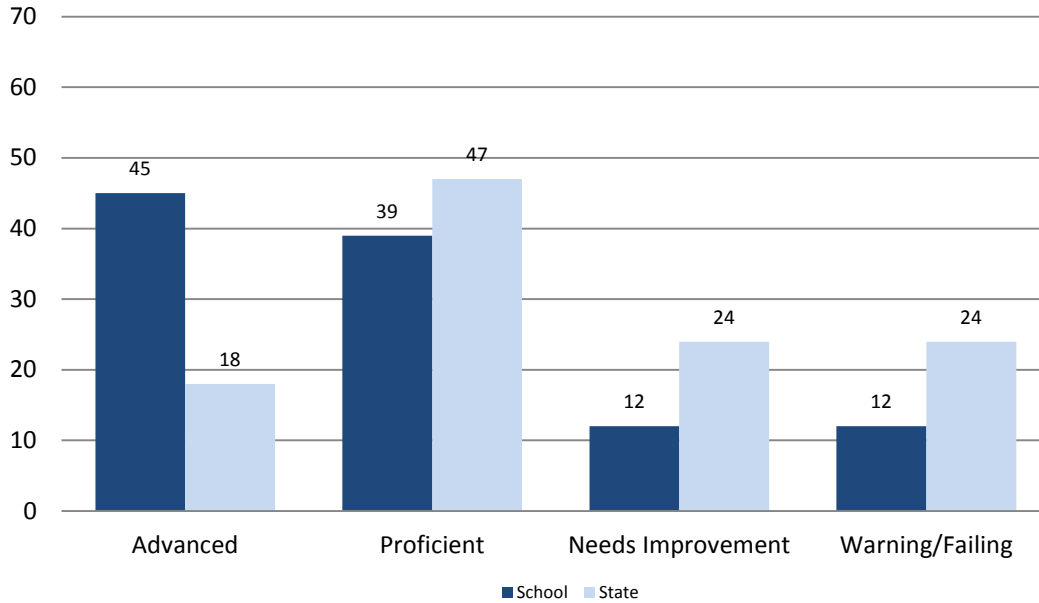
**Orleans Elementary

Compared to State Average**



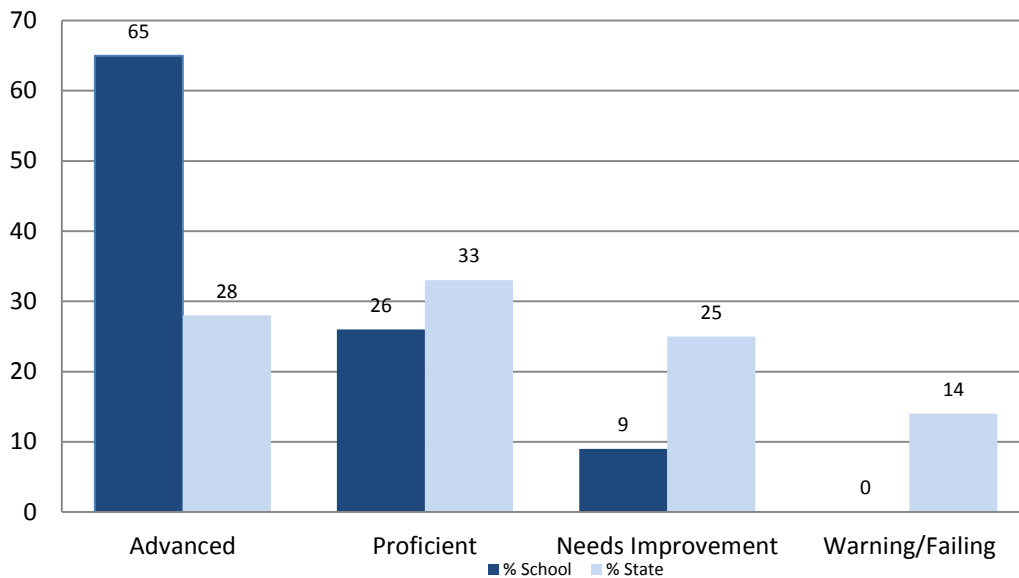
