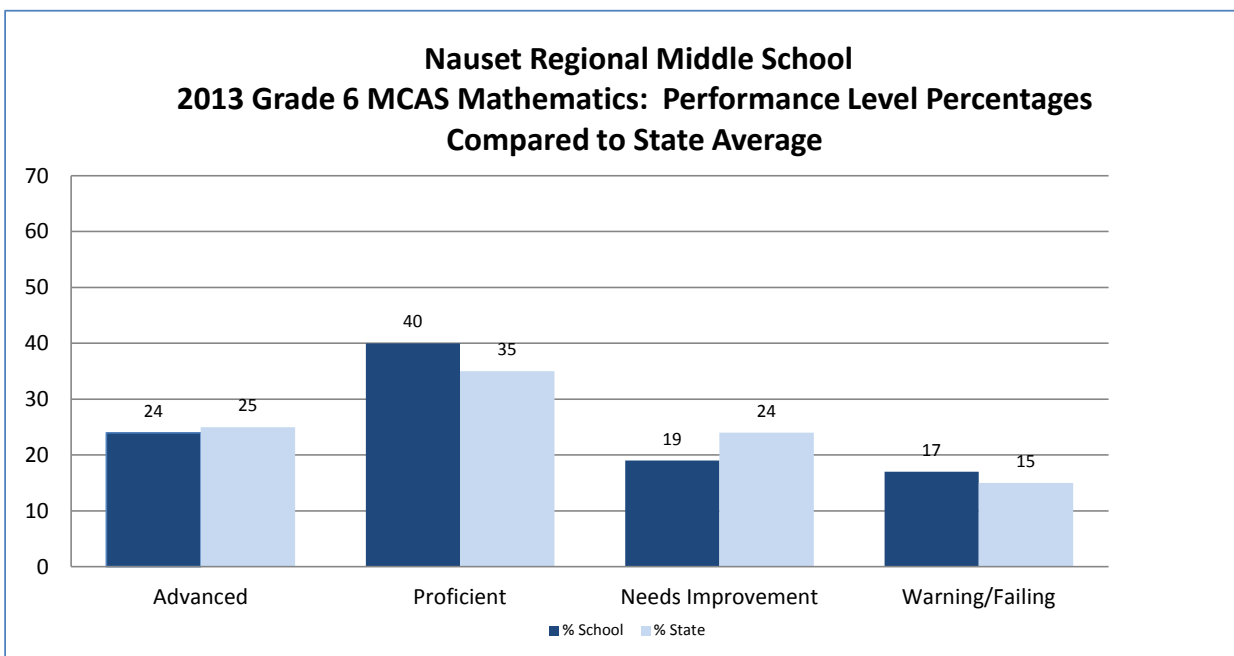
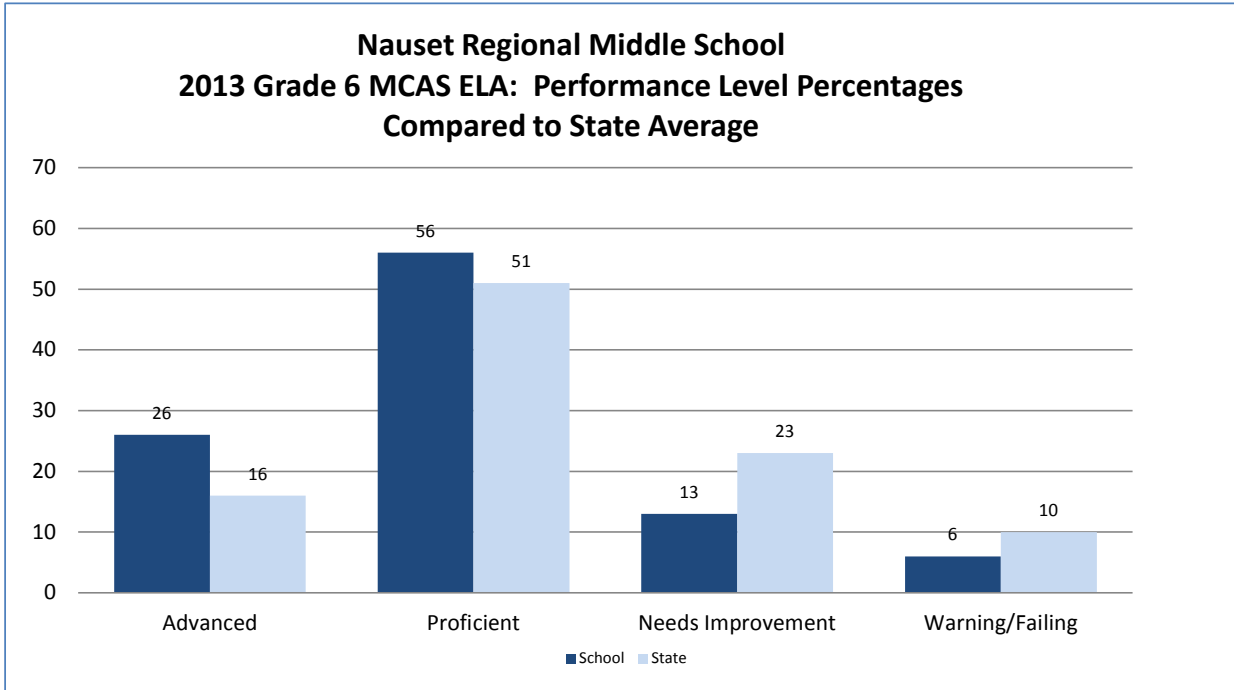
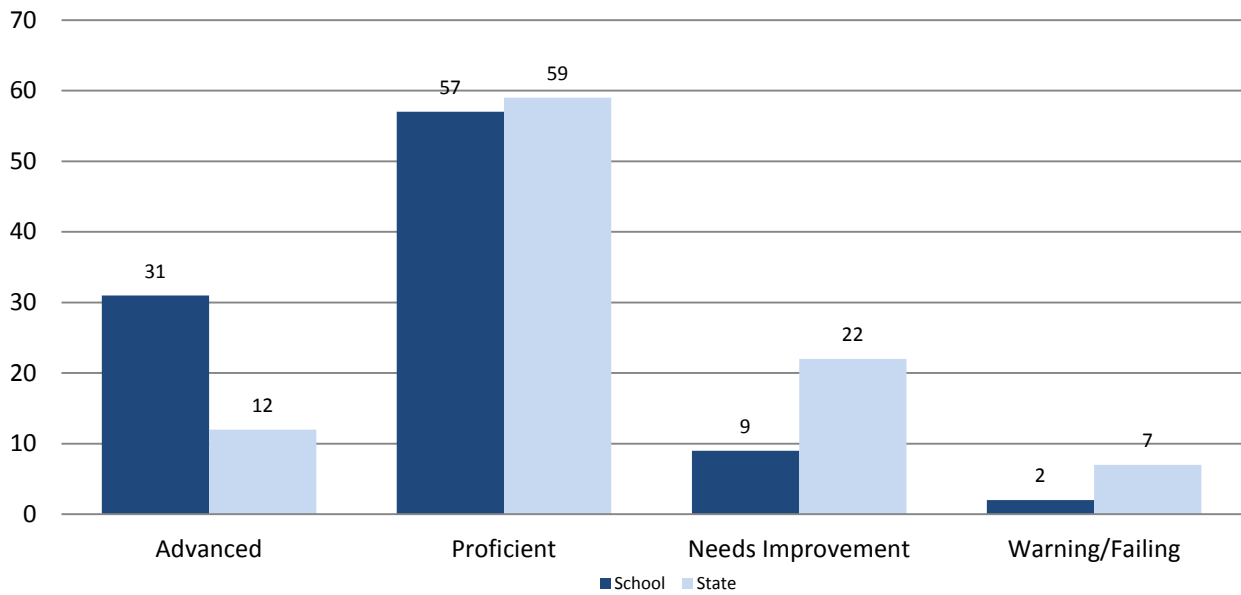


2013 MCAS Scores: Nauset Regional Middle School Level of Performance

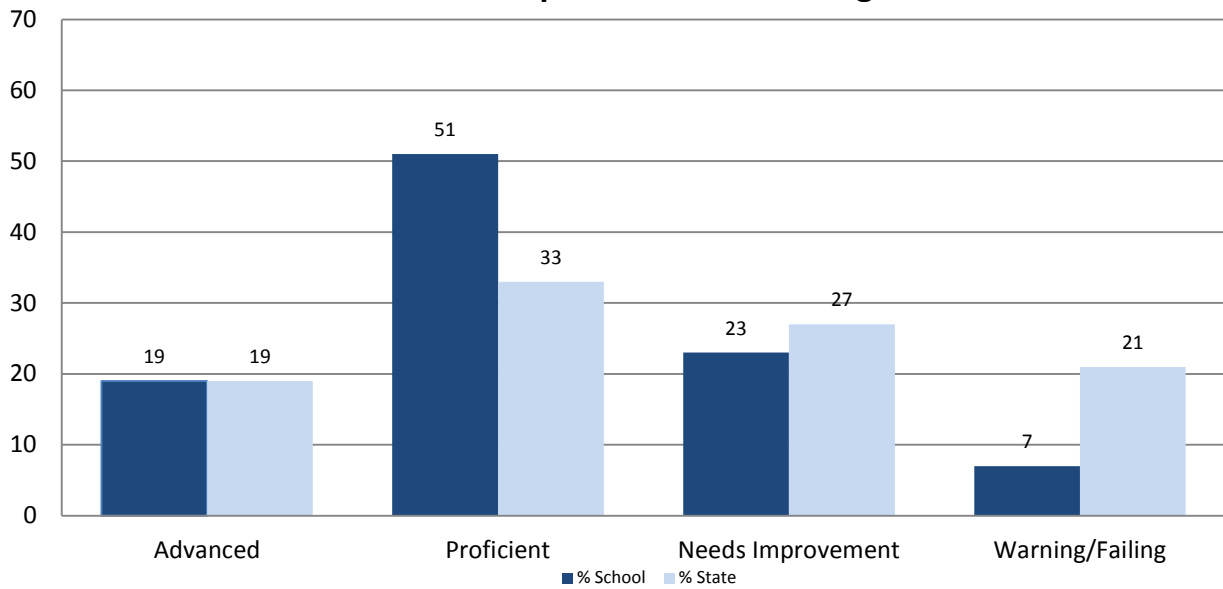
In 2013, Nauset Regional Middle School earned a Composite Performance Index (CPI) of 93.9 in ELA for all students. In mathematics, the CPI for all students was 85.4, and in science the CPI rose 0.5 percentage points to 84.6. These scores reflect a significant percentage of students scoring in the Advanced or Proficient categories; specifically, in grade 6, 82% of all students scored Advanced or Proficient in ELA, and in grade 7, 88% scored Advanced or Proficient in ELA. Eighty-seven percent of Grade 8 students scored Advanced or Proficient in ELA, and 75% scored Advanced or Proficient in math. Our staff will engage in data analysis and dialogue to plan and implement strategies to address areas requiring growth. Our long-standing commitment to advancing education ensures a continued focus on student growth and achievement.



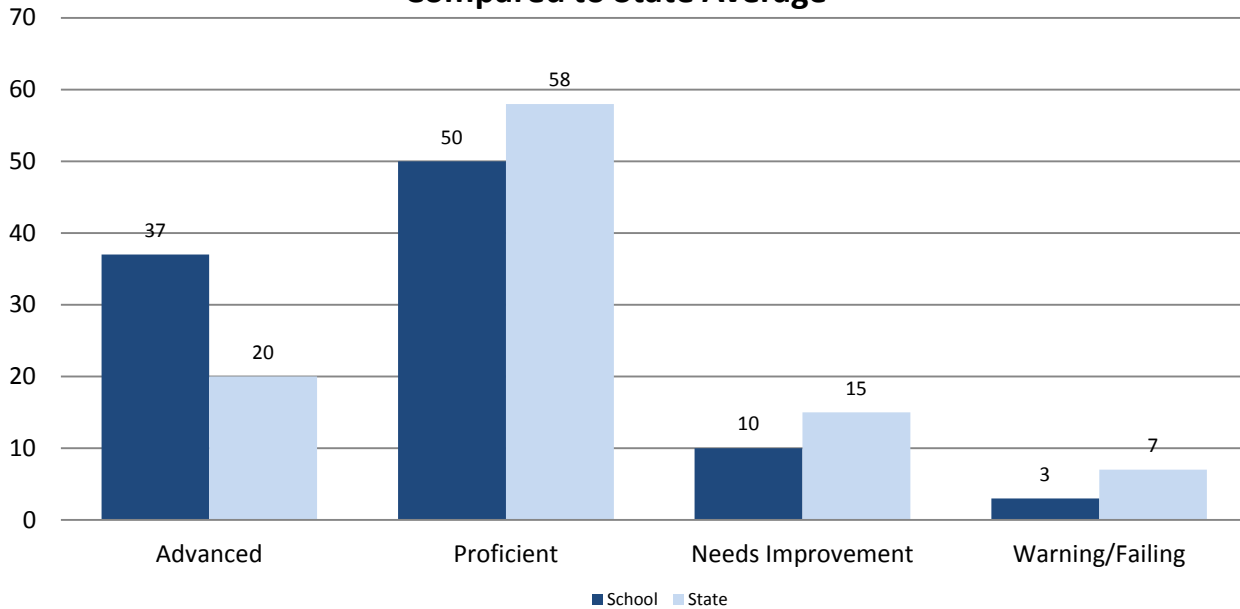
**Nauset Regional Middle School

Compared to State Average**



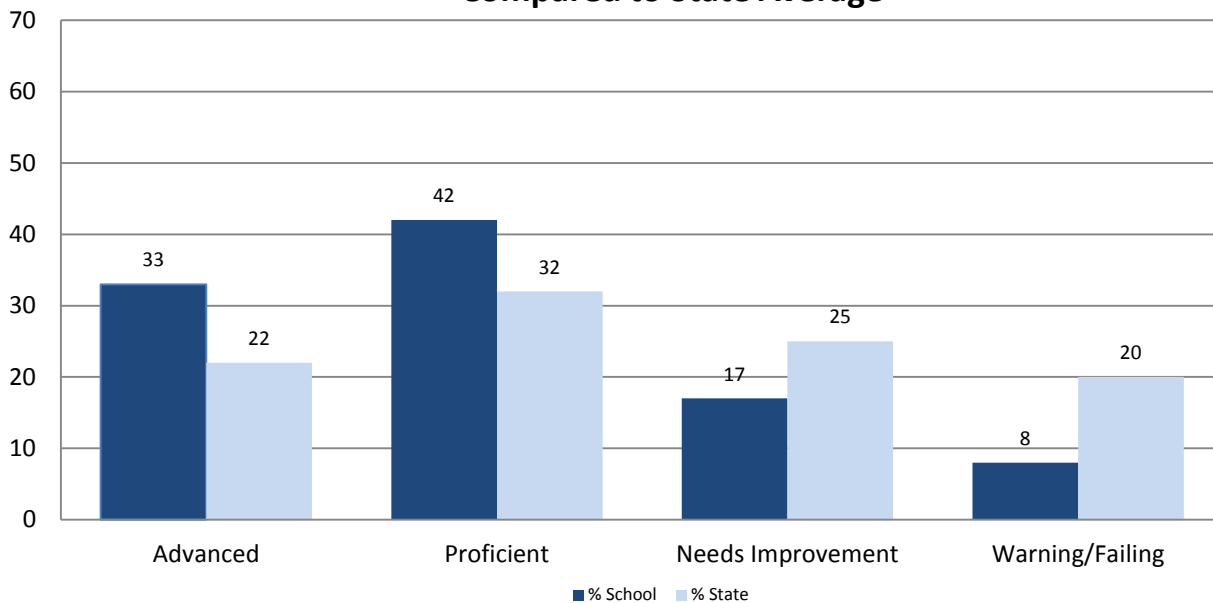
**Nauset Regional Middle School

Compared to State Average**



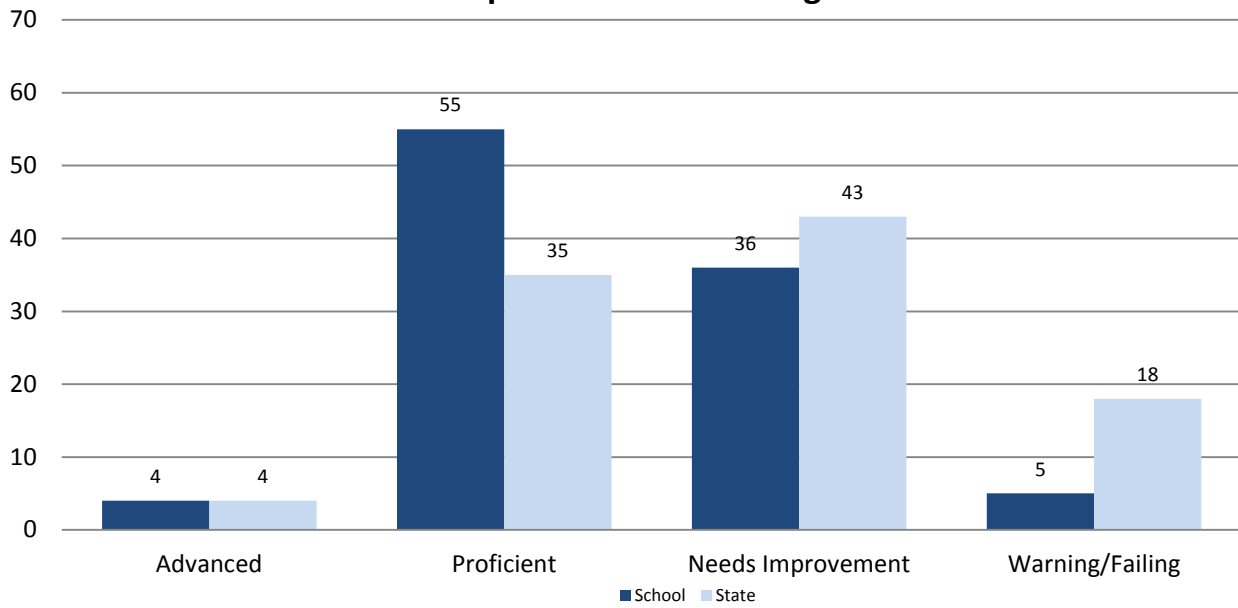

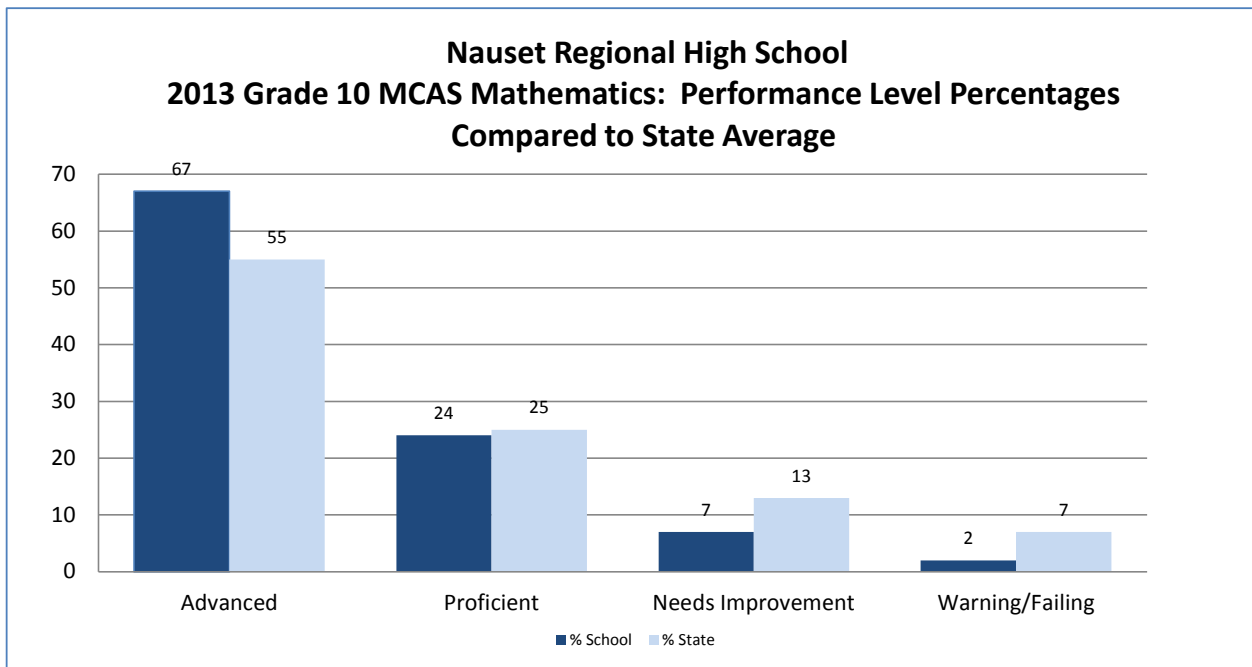
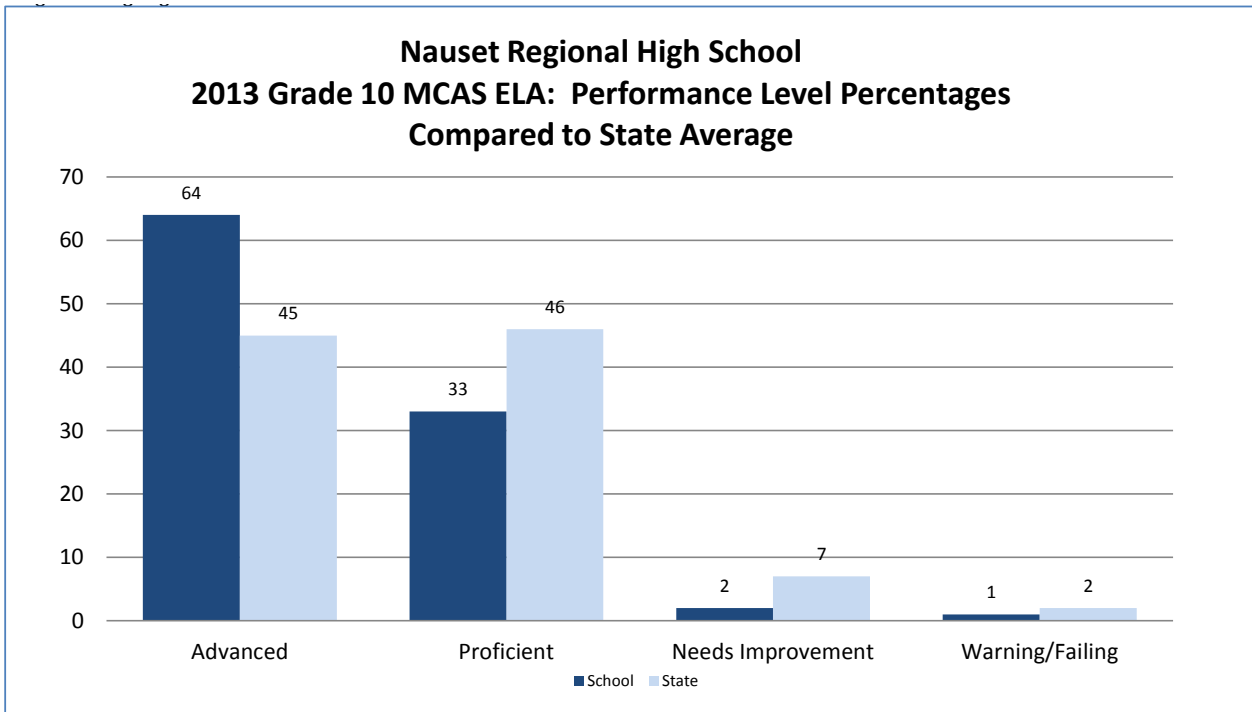

2013 MCAS Scores: Nauset Regional High School Level of Performance

In 2013, Nauset Regional High School earned a Composite Performance Index (CPI) of 99.4 in ELA for all students including a 98.3 CPI for High Needs students and a 96.9 CPI for students with disabilities. In addition, the CPI for all students was 96.6 in math and 96.0 in science. These scores result in “On or Above Target” ratings for all subgroups. Nauset Regional High School also achieved a Cumulative Progress and Performance Index of 84 for all students and 87 in the High Needs category given a state target of only 75. These scores reflect a significant percentage of grade 10 students scoring in the Advanced or Proficient categories; specifically, 97% scored in these performance levels in ELA, 91% in math, and 87% in science. Nauset Regional High School received extra credit points in science increasing the percentage of students scoring Advanced by 10%. The school also received extra credit points in ELA and science for decreasing the percentage of students scoring Warning/Failing by 10%. Our long-standing commitment to advancing education ensures a continued focus on student success and achievement.
